- > **SECTION I STANDARD:** In accordance with NIGC Regulations, the Mescalero Apache Tribal Ordinance and controls set forth and approved by the Mescalero Apache Tribal Gaming Commission (MATGC) in regards to safeguarding and protecting Tribal Gaming Assets.
- ➤ **SECTION II POLICY:** The following policy shall apply to all Gaming Vendors, Gaming Suppliers, Gaming Consultants and any entity and its employees that conduct business that is related to gaming, with the Enterprise and/or its casinos. It is the responsibility of all departments to enforce this policy by contacting Security or MATGC.
  - 1. <u>General</u>: Gaming vendors, suppliers, consultants, manufacturers, service/repair personnel (these individuals/companies will be referred to as *Vendors*) are authorized to gamble and use the gaming facilities with the following stipulations:
    - a. Vendors are strictly prohibited from gambling on Gaming Machines, Table Games or any game that uses their equipment or on which the Vendor perform services, such as maintenance, updates, etc.
    - b. Vendors "uniform" (i.e. shirt/pants with company logo, name, etc.) and badge/id must not be visible while gambling
    - c. Aristocrat Technologies Inc.: Aristocrat employees with access to the OASIS system will be prohibited from playing gaming machines. Technicians that work on gaming machines only must follow a. and b. above.
  - **2.** <u>Violations</u>: Violators of this policy shall have their gaming privileges automatically revoked and a fine levied against their company/employer.

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
